The Youth Girls Alpine Lions will also kick off on the same weekend with the girls play at home in Whorouly on Sunday, 2<sup>nd</sup> April.


Thursday nights at the rec will recommence on Thursday 30<sup>th</sup> March – meals and team selection – all welcome to attend and mingle with the players and coaches.

### **WHOROULY HOTEL**

With the relocation of the post office from the hotel to the café, we have amended opening hours for the pub.

Monday to Friday, the pub opens at 3pm and closes, generally, around 7pm on Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays and Sundays.

Meals are served on Wednesday, Friday and Saturday evenings from 6pm and finish around 8.30pm, with the pub closing when the last person leaves (or gets kicked out!).

On Saturday, Sunday and public holidays, the pub opens at 1pm.

Swap-n-go gas and ice are both available at the café when the pub is closed.

### **WHOROULY CAFÉ & POST OFFICE**

A reminder about the opening hours for Whorouly Café & Post Office.

We are open Monday to Friday from 8.30am until 5pm, but please note postal staff (ie Corina) goes to lunch between 1pm and 2pm, so you may not be able to access postal services during this time.

The café is also open on weekends and public holidays from 8.30am to 4pm, but the post office is closed.

### **RAIN FOR WHOROULY**

Whorouly's total rainfall for February was 37.8mm, according to the TAFCO weather monitor.

There were only three days in February that recorded significant (above 10mm) rainfall, including 13.8mm on the 6th.
